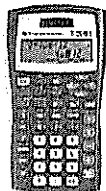

Calculator:



8th Grade Math Course – the TI 34II Explorer Plus Calculator is preferred. The TI-30 XS Multiview or any comparable scientific calculator with the π (Pi) and $\sqrt{\quad}$ buttons is acceptable.



8th Grade Algebra Course - the recommended calculator for this course is the TI 83-Plus – Graphing Calculator. New York State requires the use of a graphing calculator for the Regents Integrated Algebra Examination, in June. Also, this calculator will be utilized throughout your child's high school math courses.

As per New York State Educational Website, "The graphing calculator should be used for all types of classroom activities and homework as an integral part of the three Regents-approved commencement level mathematics courses, *Integrated Algebra*, Geometry, and Algebra 2/Trigonometry."
