My worst day was the day of a fatal car accident.


Have you ever been injured on-duty? If so, how?

Scrabble, I guess. I don't really play a lot of games.




What do you enjoy about working at the school?

Going home at the end of each day & graduation.






OFFICER GROSS

About 10. All the judges around here know that if I write you a ticket - you deserved it!





Have you ever been injured on-duty? If so, how?

What was your favorite memory from high school?



No.


What do you enjoy about working at the school?
